## **Participation in Research Group Activities**

## **Eligibility Requirements for Title V Chemistry Research Scholarship**

Title V Chemistry Research Scholarship recipients are selected by the chemistry faculty. The maximum number of scholarships that can be awarded is determined by the funding available for a given summer session. It may or may not be possible to award scholarships to all qualified students in a given summer. To be eligible to apply for a Title V Chemistry Research Scholarship a student must:

1. be majoring in CHEMISTRY, BIOCHEMISTRY, or FORENSIC CHEMISTRY
2. have completed at least CHEM 1340 & CHEM 1140 and be a freshmen or sophomore in good academic standing at the start of the scholarship period.
